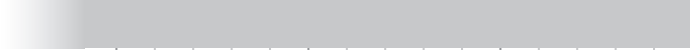


Turbotville's 150 Year History

- Philip Reifsnyder opened a tavern and blacksmith shop in 1825
- In 1856, three churches were built within the borough
- Turbotville borough incorporated on January 3, 1859
- Mt. Pleasant Grange formed in Turbotville, 1874
- Thomas A. Edison demonstrated his "electric light" in Turbotville on October 1883
- Fire destroyed 26 structures within borough in 1900
- Turbotville National Bank established in February, 1910
- First electric lights installed in 1914
- Turbotville water system installed, 1932
- Turbot-Lewis Joint School District formed in 1937
- Fire destroyed Somers and Smith store on July 5, 1957
- Turbotville celebrated its 100th anniversary in 1959
- Turbotville celebrated the Nation's Bicentennial
- Turbotville celebrates its 150th anniversary in 2009
